## Crafts Gallery

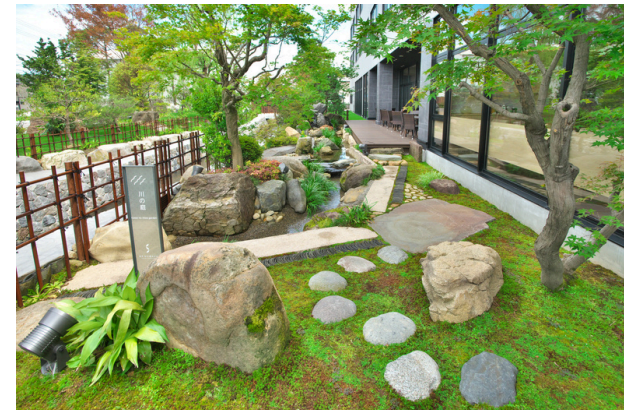
Our guest corridors double as a crafts gallery displaying the works of local artisans.
